

We support Cub Scout Pack #325 ensuring that they have a safe place to meet and to satisfy their community service hours. We also supported the Spotsylvania Sheriff's Department in helping to battle animal fighting within our community and statewide. This is just a sampling of some of the programs that we are involved in to support our community.

FOP 15# COPS AND KIDS

FOP Lodge #15 held our 28th annual FOP #15 Cops and Kids Project (formerly known as the Richard L. Parsons Memorial Shop with a Cop Project) on December 14, 2019, at 7:00 AM, at the Target store in the Central Park shopping area in Fredericksburg. We invited 173 children in need nominated by their school counselors in the city and four surrounding counties, the Thurman T. Brisben Center (homeless shelter), Loisann's Hope House (long term homeless shelter), and Empower House (domestic violence shelter) to go Christmas shopping with a law enforcement officer with a budget of \$125.00 for each child. We raise the funds for this project from a portion of our annual fundraising campaign, and from donations from our individual members, a Virginia State FOP Grant, and from our community through a small direct mail campaign.

Dozens of law enforcement officers from the City of Fredericksburg, the Counties of Caroline, King George, Spotsylvania, and Stafford, the Virginia State Police, and various other local, state, and Federal agencies, both lodge members and non-members, volunteered their time on their day off to come to the store in uniform to assist the children with their Christmas shopping. In addition, we also had student volunteers from the Fredericksburg Academy, Chancellor High School National Honor Society, and the Spotsylvania County JROTC, as well as other volunteers from the public. Our Cops and Kids Project has been a great success for these twenty-eight years and we have been able to give over 4,615 children in need the joy of experiencing a wonderful Christmas. Target has been a very generous partner in this endeavor.

Not only do they reconfigure their schedule to suit our needs by opening early for us, but they have given Cops and Kids a very generous contribution for most of these 16 years as well as excellent logistical support.

Then in 2020, everything changed due to COVID-19. First, everything was going to be "normal". Then the Target store we've partnered with since 2004 was limited to 500 people at a time, including staff, so we were going to set up C&K in three shifts from 6 AM to 8 AM. Finally, Target's upper management decided to prohibit large groups entirely. We have successfully partnered with Target for the past 16 years and they have been great about accommodating our needs from year to year. They have also donated over \$50,000.00 to Cops and Kids over the years. Therefore, it was decided that C&K would stick with them for 2020. We purchased and mailed out 170 Target gift cards for \$125.00 each to the nominees from the school counselors in the city and four surrounding counties, the Thurman T. Brisben Center, Loisann's Hope House and Empower House. The cards were accompanied with a request that they return their receipts to us along with a photo of the kid with his or her "stuff" and a note describing the recipient's shopping experience. We provided a stamped, self-addressed envelope which included each child's return address. We figured that that was about as much control as we could exert to make sure that the gift cards were used for the kids as intended. Although we only received replies from a little over 10% of the kids, some of them were priceless.

THE ROLE OF THE DIRECTOR

Lodge 15

What is the role of the Director in a Lodge? In accordance with our local lodge Constitution and By-Laws the following applies:

The Director shall attend the General Body and Board of Directors meetings. He will be named by the President and approved by the Board of Directors. He shall ensure that the policies and directives of the Board of Directors are properly carried out on behalf of the organization. The Director may be discharged by two-thirds majority vote of the board of Directors. He shall be a delegate to all Grand Lodge and State Lodge conferences, with all expenses paid by the Lodge when economically feasible and voted upon by the general membership. He shall submit to the State Secretary a report of Lodge activities. The report shall be submitted not less than thirty (30) days prior to any full State Board meeting. The Director shall submit to the State Lodge, in a timely manner, for certification, all new amendments to the Constitution and By-Laws of Rappahannock Area Lodge #15, Fraternal Order of Police, Inc., which have been approved by the general membership in accordance with Article V Section 1, of the By-Laws. The position of the Director is not elected but appointed by the Lodge President. One may also add that the Director may take on additional duties and responsibilities as determined by the Executive Board. I have volunteered to be the Lodge Charter Organization Representative for the local Cub Scout Pack, volunteered to serve on the State FOP Legislative and Media Committees and served on the State's Constitution and By-Laws Committee.

Over the course of my many years as a member of the Fraternal Order of Police, I've seen the organization grow and evolve. Needless to say, this past year has been challenging. It seems that ever since the events in Minneapolis on that fateful day on May 26, 2020, the world has turned literally upside down. I would offer that the FOP has not changed but rather the world around us has changed. That is not to say we can afford some change, but we're still a fraternal organization. Do we have racism in our midst? Sure, we do. Can we do more to being a more diverse and inclusive organization? Sure, we can.

The Virginia General Assembly and the Governor's Office are controlled by one party. Many of the pieces of legislation being proffered run counter to recruiting and maintaining qualified and motived law enforcement officers at the local and state level. I understand why these police reforms are being offered. There is a perception among politicians, and some in the public, that the law enforcement community is inherently racist. As an organization, we have our share of "bad apples". That is reflective of the society we represent.

I have participated in several Rally Days, most of which have been very friendly and cordial. However, Rally Day in January 2020 was disappointing. When members of my lodge and I met with some of the Delegates, it was clear that our messages were not being received well. We could always count on a friendly reception from the Republican Senators and Delegates. But the Democratic Senators and Delegates and their staffs were interested in advancing their legislative agenda even though it ran counter to what the FOP was advocating. As we move forward, we'll need to find a way to build bridges and work with both parties to advance legislation which enables law enforcement to serve and protect our communities. Legislation which demonizes or strips law enforcement officers of their ability to enforce the law will only serve to make our communities less safe. There are other unintended consequences of this. Businesses, large and small, which perceive their communities to be less safe are more inclined to move and thus taking the tax revenue with them. California is a good example with the loss of major corporations due to the rising cost of doing business and the lack of security.

As I to serve as the Director to my lodge, I will continue to do what I can in accordance with those precepts as laid out in the Constitution and By-Laws. I will continue to do what I can to advance the interests of the FOP in the Commonwealth of Virginia even in these uncertain times.





Wittman, Rashid debate criminal justice issues in Virginia's 1st District congressional race

Incumbent 1st District Rep. Rob Wittman and challenger Qasim Rashid squared off on August 20, 2020 in a debate over criminal justice and other issues.

The Criminal Justice Forum and Debate, held at the Rappahannock Regional Criminal Justice Academy in Spotsylvania County, was the first time the two candidates have met face to face for a debate since Rashid won the Democratic Party nomination for the congressional seat.

The 1st District, which includes much of the Fredericksburg area and stretches southeast to include the Northern Neck and Middle Peninsula, has been represented by Wittman, a Republican, since 2008.

Thursday's forum gave each candidate opportunities to express their views on a wide range of law enforcement issues that have focused a spotlight on police behavior since the May 25 death of George Floyd

at the hands of Minneapolis police. Although the candidates were generally courteous and polite to each other throughout the 90-minute event, they traded a few barbs.

"This election is about the future of our country," said Wittman. "There is a big difference between the two parties, and what they both stand for and what their ideas are about going forward."

Wittman said the standardization of a "one-size-fits-all" approach in the use of force is not in the best interest of the community and would deprive law enforcement officers of the tools they need to safely perform their duties.

"That direct accountability from communities to law enforcement leaders is exactly what needs to happen," said Wittman. "What's appropriate in Caroline County may not be appropriate in Prince William County."

But Rashid said he believes standardization is necessary to help protect the interests of law enforcement officials.

"We can't, on one hand, say that we don't want one law enforcement officer to be fired for unjust reasons while the other one is protected, and then say we don't need a national standard," Rashid said.

Rashid labeled qualified immunity, which shields government officials from being held personally liable for constitutional violations, as a "Band-Aid solution" for officers who respond to calls that involve citizens with mental health issues, drug addiction or other personal challenges. The Democrat said he favors hiring professionals to help ease the burden on police officers who respond to those calls and suggested counselors would "take the lead and let law enforcement be the backup" when calls for help come in.

"Not only are we asking law enforcement to do things that we haven't given them the tools to do, we're asking society to be content without getting the support that [law enforcement] rightfully needs and deserves," Rashid said. "So, we concocted this issue of qualified immunity to protect law enforcement officers who mean well, but the end result is, that the people who need support don't get the support they need."

Wittman said if law enforcement officers follow policies, procedures, protocols and the law, qualified immunity protects them from "frivolous lawsuits" in the performance of their duties.

"I would argue, [qualified immunity] is not concocted," Wittman said. "[It's] essential to protecting our law enforcement officers."

Another issue receiving attention following Floyd's death is the 1033 program: a Department of Defense initiative that provides law enforcement agencies with military surplus equipment for little or no cost.

Rashid said a document prepared by the Charles Koch Institute asserts military grade equipment neither improves the safety of police officers, nor decreases crime.

"But it does do something very devastating to our community, in that it creates a wedge between law enforcement and the community, it decreases trust," said Rashid.

He added that money saved by not purchasing and maintaining surplus items could be better spent on broadband for citizens in rural areas, or for teacher and police salary increases.

Wittman, who supports the 1033 program, said procurement of equipment under the program should be left to local agencies to determine.

"Instead of having a mandate from Washington saying that 1033 equipment doesn't make you safer ... I believe in your decision-making," he said.

About 70 guests attended Thursday's debate. Attendance was limited due to the coronavirus pandemic, and the majority in attendance were current or former law enforcement officers.

Neil Hornung of the Fraternal Order of Police Rappahannock Area Lodge 15 in Spotsylvania asked both candidates for their views on the use of non-lethal weapons, specifically during protests and demonstrations.

"You either go from a verbal command to using your firearm, or you have something in the middle that helps save lives," said Hornung.

Hornung, who said he wants both law enforcement officers and those they come in contact with to return home safely each night, noted that several communities have already prohibited the use of non-lethal weapons.

Both candidates said they support non-lethal methods of law enforcement.

Jake Salmons of Stafford asked the candidates if they supported defunding police or redirecting police resources elsewhere.

"No, I don't want to defund police," Rashid said. "In fact, I want to get my own party to argue that we should make sure law enforcement should get the support they need."

Wittman said he, too, does not support defunding the police, and added, he favors increasing police resources overall.

2020 VIRGINIA STATE FOP CONFERENCE

Rappahannock Area Lodge #15 was fortunate enough to host the November 5-7, 2020 State conference in the midst of a pandemic. In preparation for the conference, we had set out to make the registration and events package as easy as possible through the use of a website. The site was one of the initiatives to streamline registration for the conference. The conference site was the Fredericksburg Hospitality House (FHH). The Conference Committee had been in touch with the FHH management since Lodge #15 was chosen as the 2020 State Conference site. We had signed a contract, put money down, made arrangements for various entertain-

But as luck would have it, and after much persistence, the parent company decided to open the FHH for the conference. As a result, and some last-minute arrangements, we were able to host the conference. What was unique was that the FOP were the only guests in the hotel. Which proved to be a good thing, especially with the swinging hospitality suite.

The conference was shortened by a day due to the fact that election day was November 3. As we kicked off the opening ceremony on Thursday, November 5th conference attendees had an opportunity to hear from Fredericksburg City Mayor, Mary Katherine Greenlaw and also from Spotsylvania County Sheriff Roger Harris. We were fortunate to have a combined Honor Guard from the Fredericksburg Police Department, Spotsylvania Sheriff's Office and the Stafford County Sheriff's Office. We had an FOP member from one of the other lodges in the state play the bagpipes. We were very pleased to have our National President Pat Yoes address the conference attendees. During his opening remarks, President Yoes noted that it has been a challenging year for the law enforcement community. He cited some statistics which indicate that 77% of the American population

believe their police departments are doing a good job. This contradicts some narratives and demonstrates how much most Americans appreciate the law enforcement community. President Yoes highlighted some achievements by the National Board over the past year.

- 1. Increased communication Constantly pushing information out and being shared.
- 2. Changed the way we do business More people involved and more forward thinking 5, 10, 15 years from now. Adopted 35 action items that will put us on course for that and some already in place
- 3. Officer Wellness put a committee in place and programs to address Officer wellness Hired a Director of Officer Wellness Traumatic events can change the life of people; it is estimated Officers have 60-70 traumatic events in their career depending on where we live. Suicide has been a killer of LEO due to PTSD
- 4. Technology we are constantly finding new ways to help us do a better job

- 5. Disaster Relief and Disaster Response Trailer Serves as a mobile kitchen and command post to assist communities of Law Enforcement during a disaster. Cops helping Cops! All of this has been paid for through corporate sponsors and cost the FOP nothing. Will feed thousands of people.
- 6. Commission on Law Enforcement President Yoes worked with the Trump Administration and had several FOP members appointed to the committee
- 7. Covid-19 Recognized very quickly our members were in jeopardy. National FOP worked with DOJ which had issued an Order of Presumptive that an Officer who contracts Covid-19 does not have to prove that it was contracted while working but only has to show that he was on duty. Within 7 days this was put in place to protect our Law Enforcement Officers. Congress has certified it.
- 8. Qualified Immunity has been a hot topic and many legislations are reviewing whether to keep QI for their law enforcement agencies. National FOP is working to address this to reverse this trend nationally.
- 9. The National FOP has a team working full time and making sure the message is getting out there.
- 10. National FOP has hired a Public Relations firm to help manage our message. We need to speak with one voice. Hired the firm to help provide a tool kit. Electronic tool kit and if locals will find 2-3 things and start having the conversations with our local communities. On the National level, they are playing defense in DC but on the Local lodge level we are playing offense. Use the tool kit to have fact-based conversations. Find some things your lodge can pull out of it. One Voice!
- 11. Only organization who held a process for endorsements. Locals told state who told the State Trustee who voted and for the first time it was a unanimous vote to support a Presidential Candidate. The Law Enforcement community is in for some tough times right now, expect it. Let's leave politics at the door and do what we do best and serve our community. No matter who the President is, we are still going to try and work with them.

During the course of the 1st Day of the conference, a memorial service was held for all of the fallen officers within the Commonwealth of Virginia. The service was led the Virginia FOP State President John Ohrnberger, State Auxiliary President Gale Stiles and State Associate Lodge President Marci Blum. The combined color guard was furnished by the Fredericksburg Police, Spotsylvania Sheriff's Office and Stafford Sheriff's Office. That evening, we held an "Oktoberfest" with the traditional German Beer, Pretzels and Bratwurst. Many of the attendees really enjoyed the German Beer.

One of the many highlights of the State Conference was to provide some variety in the entertainment packages as well as some training. We invited the author of Toxic Blues, Steve Neal to provide a one-day seminar on the topic of leadership as well as the challenges in the law enforcement profession. Attendees to the State Conference received a copy of his book. We had arranged several tours in the local area. Of note was the Bowman Distillery, Potomac Winery, as well as Fredericksburg Battlefield Tours. In addition to the business of the state conference, several attendees and their family members were able to take advantage of these specials even in the midst of the pandemic. Based on the feedback received, everyone seemed to enjoy themselves.

One of the more contentious issues raised during the State Conference was the current per capita being charged to the local lodges. It was noted that some lodges may have some challenges with the increased per capita, but in order to ensure the continued viability of the FOP it was necessary to make this change.

The next state conference will be hosted by the Commodore Lodge, Norfolk, Virginia. We wish the best of luck and no pandemics.

On Friday evening, we had a splendid banquet which was held at the Fredericksburg Hospitality House. The food was provided by the University of Mary Washington's Culinary Arts Students. It was very delicious. Our featured speaker was the National Secretary, Jimmy Holderfield. He provided some updates on what the National FOP is doing to ensure the Law Enforcement Profession is adequately represented and that our voices are being heard. He noted that, with the recent election, the Law Enforcement profession will face some challenges in the foreseeable future.

The Conference concluded on Saturday, November 7th. Overall, in spite of all of the obstacles thrown in our way, Rappahannock Area Lodge, #15 was able to host an outstanding Conference. Many noted that with the pandemic and the election, many conference attendees were really focused on the issues and the business of the FOP. Whenever your interests are under intense scrutiny, you tend to focus on those issues which are really important. Overall, mission accomplished.

TOP LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

- H.R. 82, the "Social Security Fairness Act," would repeal both the "Windfall Elimination Provision" and the "Government Pension Offset" in current Social Security law.
- H.R. 962, the "Law Enforcement Officers' Equity Act," would expand the definition of "law enforcement officer" for salary and retirement benefits to include all Federal law enforcement officers.
- The "Public Safety Employer-Employee Cooperation Act" would recognize the right of law enforcement and other public safety officers to bargain collectively with their employers.

OTHER LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

- The "LEOSA Reform Act" would amend the Law Enforcement Officers' Safety Act (LEOSA), which exempts qualified active and retired law enforcement officers from local and State prohibitions on the carriage of concealed firearms. to ensure that these officers are able to carry in the same venues as civilian concealed carry permit holders. It would also extend the exemption to magazine capacity and would allow active and retired law enforcement officers to access services at U.S. Post Offices, Social Security Administration offices or Veterans' Affairs facilities.
- The "Protect and Serve Act" would make it a Federal crime to target a law enforcement officer with an assault that results in serious bodily harm or death.
