8:30 am – 11:30 am Emergency Management Training for Law Enforcement and Private Security

Law enforcement and security personnel most of the time, are first to arrive on the scene. Coordinating the proper emergency response and resources to the scene is an important role placed upon us. The decisions we make at that scene in coordinating could mean the difference between life and death.

This course (7) Hour course provides sworn officers and private security personnel with a basic understanding of basic emergency management techniques that should be used in the performance of their duties in order to show & demonstrate the importance of integrating emergency management techniques to increase safety and to minimize the dangers that can result in the loss of life to other public safety personnel and the general public.

This course covers basic emergency management skills, understanding emergency management & action plans, coordinating training exercises, laws in VA regarding public safety/emergency management procedures, ICS/NIMS refresher, how to coordinate with other public safety-first responders and resources on emergency management training material.
